MINUTES OF BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS MEETING

Board President Lynn Moomaw called the meeting to order at 5:57pm.

The October 16, 2023, meeting minutes were read for approval. Kyle made the motion to accept the minutes as written, Moomaw seconded and all approved.

Adam stated that the sewer generator was checked by Cummins and was told that several boards need replaced beyond the one that was fixed. Ryan asked if possibly a non-certified company could look at it before making any other repairs as a second opinion. Adam will call WW Williams as they work on our well generators.

Mayor Poulson stated that a large amount of grease has been found and must be skimmed off. Not sure where it is coming from so, we will be sending out a letter to the local businesses in town to make them aware of the issue.

Advance Water is still looking at different ways of dealing with the motors that will need attention or replacing with an auger system.


Green Local has returned the contract. The market value has been addressed so we just need the purchasing rights and we should be able to finalize the deal. We have signed an SRO contract with Green and that will run for the next 3 years. They are paying all 3 years in advance.

Mayor Poulson stated we have a council seat open and Nate Duenke is interested. Hopefully the seat will be filled soon.

Mayor Poulson also asked Lynn and Ryan if they will continue with BPA and will appoint them to the positions at beginning of year.

Kyle made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:21pm, Ryan seconded, and all approved.
