Food Truck operators must provide a copy of valid general liability insurance.

Food Truck operators must provide a valid Wayne County Ohio Mobile Food Service Operations license and it must be displayed in a prominent location.

Hours of operation shall be 8:00 am-11:00 pm March 1<sup>st</sup> - October 31<sup>st</sup>

8:00 am- 9:00 pm November 1<sup>st</sup> - March 1<sup>st</sup>

Food Trucks shall maintain a minimum separation of ten (10) feet between vehicles and/ or equipment and shall not be parked or operated within twenty (20) feet of the building.

Sanitary facilities for vendors must be provided by the host property, unless parked at the Smithville Park, when park facilities may be used.

Food trucks must be self-contained when vending, except for the required trash and/or recycling receptacles, which shall be placed in close proximity to the food truck. The Food Truck and trash receptacles shall not impede the free movement of automobiles or pedestrians.

Food trucks shall serve pedestrians only. No Drive-through or drive-in service.

There shall be no alcoholic beverage service associate with Food Truck vending.

Food Trucks shall comply with the Village noise nuisance regulations at all times.

*Any exceptions must be approved by the mayor directly.*
